Approximately 24 hours total will be spent on training time in for each location. • Complete as many session as you're able to.

Contact program administration for more information. • Participant materials and supplies provided. • Support and guidance provided by local Violence Prevention Coordinators and program staff. • Technical assistance provided by topical experts. • Format is flexible and can be altered to meet the needs of the facilitator and the community. • Logistics and planning will be handled by local facilitators with assistance from local Violence Prevention Coordinator. 	<p>Annual Time Commitment:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goal: Minimum of 3, 1-day Workshops <i>8 hrs./workshop x 3 workshops</i> <i>= 24 hours total</i> • Goal: Minimum of 3 series of 6, 1-hour Workshops <i>1 hr./week x 6 weeks = 8 hours/series x 3 series</i> <i>= 24 hrs. total</i> • Workshops are split among facilitators; for example if you have two facilitators, each could complete 3 sessions or 24 hours. Time commitment TBD based on number of facilitators, individual community needs, etc.
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
